

Public Hearing and Work Session of the Oglethorpe County Board of Commissioners were held on Monday, August 1, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Commissioners’ Office, Lexington, Georgia.

Rezone: Commissioner Sanders made a motion to approve the application submitted by Gloria Bowman to rezone property located at 1168 Arnoldsville Road also known as tax parcel 008 145 from A2 to R1 in order to subdivide. Seconded by Commissioner Norman and unanimously approved by the Board.

Conditional Use: Commissioner Saxon made a motion to approve the request to withdraw the application for a conditional use permit located on Saxon Mattox Road also known as tax parcel 186 004A. Seconded by Commissioner Norman and unanimously approved by the Board.

Board Appointment: Commissioner Sanders made a motion to appoint Kathryn Davis to fill the vacancy on the Board of Health. Seconded by Commissioner Brown and unanimously approved by the Board.

TSPLOST: Commissioner Saxon made a motion to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Oglethorpe County and the Cities of Crawford, Maxeys, Lexington, and Arnoldsville, for the Oglethorpe County 2022 Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales and Use Tax. Seconded by Commissioner Clark and unanimously approved by the Board.

TSPLOST: Commissioner Clark made a motion to approve the Resolution authorizing the imposition of a one percent transportation special purpose local option sales and use tax and to direct the Board of Elections to call a special election. Seconded by Commissioner Saxon and unanimously approved by the Board.

Proposed Budget: Chairman Paul presented the Board with the proposed 2023 General Fund Budget. No action was taken.

Administrative Consent Agenda: Commissioner Clark made a motion to approve the Administrative Consent Agenda. Seconded by Commissioner Norman and unanimously approved by the Board. The items approved were the July 11, 2022 Minutes and July Monthly Financial Report.

Other Business:

(1) Commissioner Clark addressed continued complaints regarding the rumble strips on Beaverdam Road. Chairman Paul stated he was aware and working to address the issue.
