Event Permit: Commissioner Norman made a motion to approve the application submitted by Micah Morlock for the Athens Twilight Gambler Bike Ride to be held April 30, 2022. Seconded by Commissioner Sanders and unanimously approved by the Board.

Glade VFD Request: Commissioner Saxon made a motion to endorse the decision of the Glad Volunteer Fire Department to operate as an independent fire service and authorizes the Chairman to enter into fire service agreements to that effect. Seconded by Commissioner Clark and unanimously approved by the Board.

Ordinance: Commissioner Clark made a motion to approve the Timber Harvesting Ordinance. Seconded by Commissioner Norman and unanimously approved by the Board.

Underused Properties: Chairman Paul identified four parcels of land that the Board of Commissioners owns that are without a current or potential purpose.

Commissioner Saxon made a motion to approve the purchase of a dump truck from Sansom Equipment for \$116,573.00 to be paid from Capital Replacement. Seconded by Commissioner Clark and unanimously approved by the Board.
