Report from Election Staff:

- Registration Stats for March, 2025: 11,627 Active voters, 697 Inactive voters, total of 12,324 with a gain of 39 active voters, decrease of 18 inactive voters, for an increase of 21 voters overall. (See HO)
 - Included in the March 2025 Totals, 26 voters were removed from the voters list by these actions:
 - Deceased 14
 - Mentally Incompetent 1
 - Felons 10
 - Duplicates 1
- Absentee Applications and Rollovers for the upcoming election – Elderly and Disabled Absentee Application Guidance, Voters who are elderly and disabled are normally entitled to make one absentee application, and it rollover to all elections in the cycle. However, for any special primary, special primary runoff, special election or special election runoff, voters in this category are required to apply for separate and distinct applications for an absentee ballot. (See HO)
- The House passed SB 199 with no changes, so the bill now goes to the Governor for signature.
 - This bill ends local filing of ethics paperwork for local candidates. This will not take effect until January 1, 2027.
